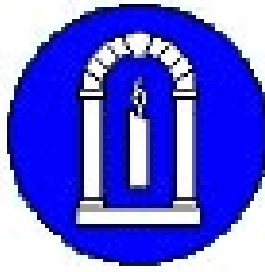

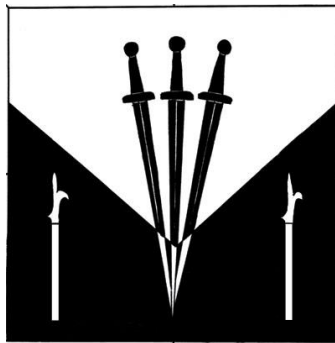
## A&S Happenings (From the Iron Bog Yahoo Group)
